Introduction

The Relationship Report for two individuals applies to any type of relationship. It focuses on the relationship itself, rather than on the individuals who make it up. First a composite chart (mid-point chart) is created. The composite chart represents the fusion of energy that two people create when they come together in relationship. It is a third being. Like a child, it inherits qualities of both parents, though it has a life all its own and exists independently of either of them. The following interpretations should be regarded as being for the relationship itself, taken as an independent entity.

In the following report, each planetary placement and aspect is examined to reveal the basic qualities of your relationship, with the most important factors described first. Please keep in mind that these descriptions are not meant to put limitations on the relationship, but merely to describe its inherent tendencies. Challenging aspects can become the greatest strength of a relationship if you can both learn how to successfully navigate those issues, with good communication between you playing a vital role. For definitions of astrological terms, please refer to the glossary at the end of this report.

Chart Patterns

T-Square, focal planet Jupiter

Jupiter in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared experience where you will find mutual good fortune and faith in positive outcomes.

Jupiter in the First House (or sign) indicates a relationship that is strong in selfesteem. You are expansive and abundant together, and are likely to have good luck with the material side of your lives. Your relationship to each other and with the world grows through your shared passion for freedom and independence, and also a penchant for fun and adventure. In a romantic context, a feeling of can-do is an important component of your self-image with each other. You are unusually fortunate in most things that you attempt, and possess a jovial sense of fun that makes your way easier along your shared road. You have an extremely optimistic nature as a duo. You two tend to see possibility in everything, jointly viewing the glass as half-full rather than half-empty. This is valuable, and takes you far in life. You benefit by making sure that the natural faith you have in your relationship's power remains grounded and focused on assessing practical steps in a sustainable way and when you temper your boundless enthusiasm with a healthy sense of limitation.

Composite Jupiter in Cancer (or the fourth house) magnifies the loving, kind and caring qualities within your relationship. Your connection with each other is likely to be friendly and sociable, generous and high-minded. You two have an instinct for nurturing others as well as yourselves, and find enjoyment, opportunity and growth in this type of tribal sharing. Together you may possess excellent executive abilities. You share an inherent spirituality, which is displayed not in philosophy, but in acts of love and kindness. You work well in partnership with the public, and attract material rewards without seeming to try for them. In a romantic relationship, you share a natural sense of security, and enjoy each other's family and your own if you have one together. You will have good luck with finding and maintaining a joyful and beneficial home environment. You may find that you bring out the best part of each other's relationship to your early conditioning. You may also find a sense of contentment in performing the simple chores around your shared environment. This relationship will undoubtedly help to expand the consciousness within each of you regarding your background and sense of security, and facilitates your shared exploration of the mystical and the marvelous side of life.

Important Features

Composite Moon in Aries (16° Ari 29' 31") Composite Moon in the Tenth House Ruler of Rising Sign

The placement of the composite Moon defines the core emotional focus of your relationship. It indicates the most sensitive area between you.

With the composite Moon in the Tenth House, the emotional field of this relationship partakes of a serious and practical nature. This placement is a natural one for business partnerships, and in other forms of relationship there is likely to be a strong focus on business matters, or success in the public arena. The two of you can achieve much success working together as a team, with strong emotional support for each other and few disagreements. In a more intimate context, you may find that you deal with each other in a rational and controlled way, in spite of your strong sense of emotional connection with each other. Your partnership also has a natural ability to find public acceptance of its shared social vision. This lends itself well to conflict resolution, since you are consistently able to seek out a fair and just solution based on the high moral principles that you hold in common with each other.

The composite Moon in Aries indicates a relationship that provides a strong and solid base for a wide range of emotional expression between you. In your relationship, emotions are likely to be keenly felt, direct and spontaneous. You two tend to have an ardent feeling nature with inclinations toward quick bursts of passion, expressing vour independence and impulsiveness. You may be the first ones to respond to a problem when it comes your way. Regardless of how you operate on your own, you tend to jointly react to situations with action rather than reflection. In a romantic relationship, you enjoy a shared capacity for fun and fireworks, although your passion may be variable. Allow the passion to come when it comes, and go when it goes; you can trust it will eventually return again, as enthusiastically as ever. In this relationship, you may find you can hold space for each other so you can each share pent up feelings from experiences in the outside world. You may find you also have a strong competitive streak when you are together, which, combined with an attackfirst attitude, may reveal subtle feelings of insecurity if carefully examined. Composite Saturn in Gemini (13° Gem 23') Composite Saturn in the Twelfth House

Saturn in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared experience where you will encounter limitations and build long-lasting success through trials of accomplishment.

Saturn in the Twelfth House (or sign) makes for an odd match, bringing a blockage or a concentration of energy to a power that is as vast and diffuse as the ocean itself. There may be a strong sense of hidden emotional currents between you that will bear further exploration in order to bring them to more conscious awareness. You also may find that you possess a joint focus on the mystical side of life. In a romantic relationship, you may trigger in each other, or help elucidate in each other, the feeling that life is too hard, or that it is beyond your conscious control. You two can be moody and introspective together, or simultaneously compassionate and sympathetic to each other's problems, and to the problems of those who cross your path. In the context of this relationship, you possess in concentrated form the urge for spiritual evolution that is present in all of us, and which requires detachment from the personal self in the quest for mystic union with all mankind. You seek stability in unusual ways with this placement, through the mastery of detaching from a need to rely on convention. You might to watch for a shared tendency to lapse into resignation or conversely, to try too hard to achieve control. You true path of

Composite Saturn in Gemini (or the third house) brings out in this relationship a deepening and concentrating of your mental powers and your facility with issues of speech and communication. You may jointly feel a sense of limitation in this area. The success of your connection may well depend on how much focus you can muster for your shared communication systems. In a romantic context, you can trigger, and help heal each other, around subconscious fears of intellectual inadequacy and patterns of isolation and loneliness. You benefit when you work to develop your capacity to listen deeply and intently to each other, and to hold space for each other when the situation calls for it. Don't be afraid to write things down. These skills bring increased intimacy to your companionship and shrewdness to your business ventures. Composite Uranus in Leo (21° Leo 49') Composite Uranus in the Second House

Uranus in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared experience where you will encounter unusual and unexpected circumstances and where the relationship benefits from lack of structure.

Uranus in the Second House (or sign) symbolizes a relationship with an eclectic focus on shared security and material possessions. You are likely to be concerned about maintaining stability in what is almost guaranteed to be a changing environment. You may have shared possessions or finances that you value at one point, but this can change rather suddenly, and you may have to start over from scratch. In a romantic context, your shared income can also fluctuate. As a result of all this flux, you may find it easier to simply create your own set of values, or to experiment with alternative lifestyles. If yours is a working partnership, you are likely to value your autonomy and you may be motivated to start your own business together. You two benefit from getting in touch with what you truly value, as opposed to what conventionality dictates. Composite Uranus in Leo (or the fifth house) signifies an original quality to your relationship's creative expression in the world. In a romantic context, you two may be unconventional in the way you express your sense of play and your sexuality. Children are likely to be a source of great interest but you may have difficulties in giving them steady warmth and affection. You can be very creative together, especially in the arts. You are fortunate in being able to support each other in the exploration and development of your individual talents. This placement supports innovation at the

cost of stability, but stability may be overrated when things are this interesting. In any case, your relationship benefits from developing follow-through, focus and selfdiscipline in order to successfully complete what gets inspired at the start.

Composite Mars in Virgo (22° Vir 28') Composite Mars in the Third House Angular planet - conjunct Nadir

The placement of Mars in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared activity in pursuit of partnership goals, and where ego needs may be identified.

Mars in the Third House (or sign) brings an alert, witty and energetic drive to your relationship. You two are adventurous and physically active together, with a gift for quickly adapting to changing circumstances. Your connection brings out the talkative and communicative side of each of you. Glib in speech, you get your ideas across very well with each other and with those around you, although you may be better talkers than listeners. You bring life to new ideas. If the relationship has any weaknesses in this area, it is in a tendency for you to be somewhat sharp with each other, or possibly indulge in gossip together. In a romantic relationship you find that talking is almost as good as physical interaction and that sex is boring without it. On the positive side, you will find you can communicate together regarding just about anything, and also make good facilitators when working with others. Together, you possess a natural mechanical ability and do many things well. You might benefit by learning to apply more focus and better concentration to your shared energies.

Composite Mars in Virgo (or the sixth house) brings out a kind energy between you with a strong, shared drive for work and service. Together, you possess a tremendous desire to be helpful to others. You make a practical and hard-working duo with an ability to hit the nail on the head and complete tasks that you have set out for yourself. You may perhaps need to work through getting into conflicts over trifles at times. In a romantic context, you have a serious rather than a playful attitude toward shared activity. There may be a tendency for unsynchronized timing to arise between you, such when one wants to be served by the other unequally, but these difficulties can yield to a well-developed patience and a sense of humor. You may find greater fulfillment in your relationship when you take turns serving each other. It may prove helpful to you as a partnership to set your exacting sights on wider vistas. You benefit when you learn to see the forest as well as the trees, and to apply your tremendous capacity of effort in ever broader ways to serve others around you.

Composite Sun in Libra (23° Lib 02' 39") Composite Sun in the Fourth House

The placement of the composite Sun defines the core identity of your relationship, and the place where it finds its greatest vitality. It gives you a sense of the predominant flavor of the relationship.

The composite Sun in the Fourth House indicates a deeply intuitive coupling. The two of you have a shared focus on establishing a protective base, a harbor of refuge for each other in the midst of the larger world that surrounds you. In a romantic connection, you tend to value working together for the safety and stability of what you feel really matters to you, whether that be raising a family, taking care of stray animals, or creating ground for a favorite social cause. You are likely to desire to live together, and if possible own land. This relationship is more likely to express itself in traditional ways than in eccentric or unconventional forms. Though this may not sound like the most sizzling of all possible romantic or sexual connections, it radiates power and depth, and carries a deeply held sense of reassuring support. You may find that together you deeply explore your family dynamics, such as common patterns from your childhood, or the basis of your sense of security. The field of psychology is one possible avenue for a continuing joint exploration of what makes you tick, and others also. Whatever you do together, there is a strong emotional and subjective basis and your rational conscious minds may be relegated to playing a bit part.

The Composite Sun in Libra indicates a relationship that centers on the principles of harmony and beauty. Libra is the sign of balance and relationship, and strives for harmony between polarization, and the Sun there makes for a particularly strong placement in composite charts. Your relationship is likely to exude good taste, elegance and charm. You are natural partners for each other, and your preferred mode of living is in relationship, and in abiding connection with others that you meet through life. An excellent outlet for your joint love of beauty is in artistic pursuits of all kinds. In a romantic relationship, this is obviously a very good sign for a committed partnership. Intimacy stands as an exceedingly high value for you both, as does the principal of justice and fairness between you. You will likely go out of your way to avoid a guarrel. If and when conflict arises, the best course of action for you will be to stop immediately and take space for a while. . As a partnership, you may find that you have a tendency to understand and support both sides of a dispute. You may also find that together you have a hard time making a decision. You benefit from strengthening your will to act in favor of your higher purpose, which lies ultimately in dedicating yourselves and your partnership to humanitarian ideals.

Composite Pluto in Sagittarius (8° Sag 42') Composite Pluto in the Sixth House

Pluto in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared experience where you will encounter your mutual drive for power and which will be transformative for the relationship.

Pluto in the Sixth House (or sign) correlates to a relationship where there is a need to sacrifice to the other and to the relationship. As a partnership, you may also experience a strong desire or even a compulsion to be of service to the general good or to others that you encounter. You may find you are working through very deep-seated unconscious dynamics of being truly helpful and available to others. In a romantic relationship, in order to prevent power struggles that inevitably play out

within the issues of sharing and service to each other, it is important that you carefully turn the light of consciousness onto the working dynamics of the relationship. In spite perhaps of a culture that does not encourage it, you benefit when you develop an ability to mutually acknowledge the power dynamics at play, and to begin to cultivate a very real and sincere humility, or take the time to access built-up and unresolved emotions within you, and just let it be. It can be very helpful when you become aware of the compulsion to create crisis, and take time out from the relationship in order to practice deeply forgiving each other from this, and possibly other, lifetimes. Composite Pluto in Sagittarius (or the ninth house) correlates with a relationship that is focused on higher-mind understanding and moral or ethical belief systems, perhaps excessively. You two have a heightened capacity for objective introspection and deep truth telling. Together you may have a strong drive to express your ideas to each other and to others in your sphere of influence. You may need to combat potentially dogmatic responses to the ideas of others, or a tendency to regard your particular philosophy or cause as the only one. In a romantic connection, you are likely to try to influence each other regarding your philosophy of life or shared belief system. If you agree on your basic beliefs, then this area may represent a powerful focus for you, with a life-changing quality to it, but if you disagree there may be trouble in settling down into a common grove. You benefit when you learn to let your partner's ideas coexist with your own, without needing to fix the situation, and when you speak to each other absolutely honestly in order to allow for a free and easy expression of ideas between you. Composite Venus in Scorpio (8° Sco 23') Composite Venus in the Fifth House Ruler of sun sign - Sun's ruler

The placement of Venus in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared emotional focus and love and where mutual enjoyment and benefit lies.

Venus in the Fifth House (or sign) indicates that there is a solid basis of affection in your relationship, and excellent support for creativity between you. This placement indicates good will and fun times together. You are also likely to be extremely creative as a pairing. Artistic productions come naturally to you. In a romantic relationship, there is plenty of sizzle, plus an abiding feeling of joy and laughter. You relate to each other with a child-like joie de vivre that can go a long way toward making up for any distresses that you may face as a couple. You may be interested

in having children together; certainly they are a great source of pleasure for the two of you. You admire each other for your creative bent, which this relationship may bring out in larger measure than when you operate individually. As a partnership, you may find that you need to get more serious occasionally, since things seem to come your way almost too easily. Together you have a solid basis of self-worth and may only need to ensure that you don't take the relationship too much for granted.

Composite Venus in Scorpio (or the eighth house) indicates a deep emotional connection between you and also a solid basis in your relationship for shared finances. In your partnership, a great deal of value is placed on feelings. There is likely to be a serious degree of affection between you with an intensity of emotion that runs deeper than ordinary friendship. Over the course of time, one or both of you may come into a new viewpoint on your own internal process of integration through the agency of this relationship. Obviously this placement makes great sense in a romantic context. Your contact goes entirely beyond surface associations and may include passionate physical connection as well as profound feelings for each other. The depth of your sharing brings powerful emotions within each of you closer to consciousness, and you may find a transformational seismic shift is unleashed within your own psyche through the love you share. As a partnership, you handle shared resources well, either your joint finances or those of others. You are adept at handling other people's money. Together you have the gift to discern what is most important in making the next fiduciary move. You will always have more to learn from each other, especially at an emotional level.

Composite Chiron in Aries (29° Ari 35'R) Composite Chiron in the Tenth House

Chiron in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared experience where you will encounter patterns of wounds and deep connection and where eventual healing and empathy will occur.

Chiron in the Tenth House (or sign) indicates a relationship that provides an opportunity to face and heal deeply held wounds regarding your vital force to act with authority and make a responsible contribution to society. In this relationship, you may find yourself somewhat rebellious of authority, while compulsively drawn to it at the same time. You may begin to be aware of experiences in your life where you had to knuckle under against your will or, conversely, where felt you had to over-exert your authority with others in a way that left them feeling oppressed. Perhaps the compulsion to be in authority that you are feeling in this relationship arose in your childhood, from a time when you were too forcefully controlled. Everyone has a basic need to be in control, and if we develop a distrust of authority as a result of early experiences, we tend to strike first rather than wait to be pushed around. These unconscious patterns can also manifest in the relationship as a penchant to achieve, only to feel ambivalent about subsequent success. This relationship may mirror ways that you felt pushed to success by the important parental figures of your childhood, without getting a chance to find your own true destiny. You may experience low self-esteem, seeking notoriety as a way of making up for feelings of worthlessness that live somewhere below your conscious level of

reasoning. In order to avoid these traps, it is good to take advantage of this relationship to get in conscious touch with your hidden feelings, and bring them into the light to explore them in detail. Once you have begun this process, it will continue as a natural part of your shared growth, allowing you both to wield a more conscious and integrated form of personal power as you move through the world together.

Composite Chiron in Aries (or the First House) indicates a relationship that provides an opportunity for the two of you to face and heal deeply held wounds with regard to your vital force to be and to initiate within the relationship. With this placement of Chiron, your very sense of the relationship may be threatened by disturbing realizations and painful memories. Together, you may work through pain that arose from feeling belittled and put down, rather than encouraged, by the significant adult figures around you in your formative years. Within this relationship you may encounter and overcome obstacles that prevent yourselves from reaching your full potential. You may find that in this relationship, you operate more from a fear of failing than from the expectation of success that would breed confidence for further achievement. You may find yourselves sacrificing your own goals to the goals of the other, or to those around you, because they seem somehow more important or at least deserving of priority treatment. Either one of you may feel a keen lack of achievement in your own life, and compensate by trying too hard to help others, putting yourself in the background. As long as these relationship patterns operate more or less unconsciously, they are difficult to overcome, so the first step in surmounting them is to become more conscious of what's going on inside. Become aware of your own pain. Acknowledge and discover more about what exactly went on in past relationships to make you both feel so resigned with your present abilities in this one. At that point you can begin to come out from behind your painful experiences and really show yourselves to each other and to the world around you. With a more conscious understanding of your own dynamics, you can begin to help others in how they deal with similar issues, transforming your false sense of vicarious achievement into a strong center of true friendship.

Composite Mercury in Scorpio (0° Sco 39') Composite Mercury in the Fourth House

Mercury in the composite chart reveals the quality of the communication process in your relationship, and an area of your shared experience where intellectual compatibility is to be found.

The composite Mercury in the Fourth House indicates a relationship with an uncomplicated communion around domestic, nurturing and security concerns. You have a natural affinity for each other, with excellent communication skills, especially with respect to your emotions, which is relatively rare. In a romantic context, this placement makes the process of sharing space much easier and more natural, whether at home or at work. The simple and basic process of getting through the day together becomes a pleasurable exercise. You can easily discuss your feelings, and the dynamics between you, although you may tend to over-analyze the relationship. As a partnership, discussion of your ideas with each other comes second-nature to you. Any shared space that you set up may become the locus of intellectual stimulation and activity. You also may have an unusual degree of access to information regarding your family, and a powerful respect for received wisdom passed down from ancestral sources.

Composite Mercury in Scorpio gives a very intensely careful and controlled quality to the communication in your relationship. You tend to make joint plans slowly, and stick to them resolutely. Your shared mental and observational powers are strong and your thoughts as a partnership run deep. You two tend to desire to connect with each other in a profound way. You may not immediately express your ideas; instead choosing to get your point across nonverbally, or when you decide that the time is right. You may also have a tendency to make judgments about each other and those around you. It benefits your relationship if you each make a practice of acceptance and understanding of each other. This bodes well for the two of you as long as you live from what is alive in you and not from fear or defensiveness. Your joint will is strong, and you have a passion for discovering the truth behind surface appearances. You tend to penetrate the depths of any subject. When you are as compassionate as you are penetrating, the relationship and all it touches can't help but truly benefit from these powers of 'psychic surgery.'

Composite Neptune in Aquarius (7° Aqu 38') Composite Neptune in the Eighth House

Neptune in the composite chart reveals the area of your shared experience where you will encounter idealization and nebulous spiritual feelings that will lead you to self-discovery.

Neptune in the Eighth House (or sign) brings out great personal and spiritual magnetism in each of you as a result of your association. You share a subtle intuition and an unusually clear ability to see into each other's depths, although there may also be a tendency to see each other somewhat through rose-colored glasses. Shared finances may also be subject to a form of idealism or even illusion. You may become more interested in otherworldly affairs, such as psychic matters or occult studies, than the everyday , or find that you share a love of sensuality and luxury together. With this relationship also, you may experience confusion over the power and/or sexual dynamics that come up between you. It may benefit you to put some extra attention into thinking and feeling through these sensitive issues . A process of spiritual transformation may take place in each of you as the relationship matures. You benefit from applying greater clarity to your shared values and to your intimate connection .

Composite Neptune in Aquarius (or the eleventh house) brings a visionary quality to your relationship. You make a popular duo, and may have a wide circle of friends. You are likely to highly value the friendships that you have, and to find a source of joy and inspiration in each other. Your abiding sense of comradeship will carry you far, although the idealism that you share regarding social connection can also lead to confusion or illusion of what is really going on in these settings. You may need to work through issues of deception within the relationship, or in friendships that you

share, or feel confusion regarding a group that you are jointly associated with. You may also together encounter issues of using social interaction to escape other responsibilities. In a romantic context, you share a highly developed social sense, and a great capacity to forgive each other and those around you. This can however distract you from a true bond with each other, which must come from a deeper place of commitment. You have before your eyes a constant vision for where society could go if it tapped into its most beneficial destiny, so that your shared ideals are lofty, and you may have difficulties to work through regarding the practical fulfillment of your dreams. When you are actualizing your potential as a partnership, you are compassionate toward your fellow beings and ready to sign up as helpers in the emerging worldview that celebrates universal brotherhood.

Sun, Moon, Rising Sign Features

Cancer Rising

The composite Rising Sign is the image that this partnership presents to others and characterizes the nature of the relationship.

With Cancer rising in your composite chart, your relationship emphasizes being nurturing and protective of each other and those around you. You tend to be security-conscious when with each other and very focused around feeling-oriented and domestic issues, such as your home if you share one together. Your ruling planet is the Moon, and you will find that your relationship takes on moods that ebb and flow like the tides. The position of the Moon in your composite chart is very important for the way that your relationship is likely to develop. If the Moon is well placed by sign and aspect, life flows easily for the two of you. Your relationship may appear passive from the outside, because acting as a team you may tend to avoid taking any sudden or direct action. Together, you may be involved with the past in some way, because the sign of Cancer is the sign of nurturing, protecting, and sustaining, and is strongly tied to the past, and Karma. In a romantic context, the nurturing quality and concern that you have for each other is likely to be a strong part of the appeal, and takes you far along the road to mutual respect and sharing. As a partnership, you tend to relate to each other and those around you from feelings rather than logic. Your kindness is sure to be appreciated by those around you, and by the public at large. You benefit from shedding the light of conscious reason on your habitual patterns, and focusing on your true goals.

Composite Jupiter in strong conjunction (fading, 1.6 degrees) with Ascendant

The strongest blend of the energies represented by these two planets.

This aspect between Composite Jupiter and Ascendant signifies an optimistic and growth oriented relationship, with high ideals and good vitality. As a partnership, you are spiritually motivated, and possess a quiet strength which is invariably helpful to others and which takes you far in the world. This is an excellent aspect for success especially in a business relationship, or in a romantic relationship or friendship that has an additional career orientation. As a partnership, you might only have to guard against being overly optimistic at times, for your enthusiasm for life takes you far. Honors and material success accompany your union. This combination gives a clear thinking and discriminating relationship. Saturn brings an extremely practical dimension to the visionary idealism of Neptune. You two are responsible, compassionate, and take social issues very seriously. You may share an engaging interest in music, dance or film, or in the healing arts. You may suffer confusion regarding restrictions imposed upon you, in which you feel both attracted to the security imposed by such limits, and simultaneously repelled or stifled by these restrictions. With this placement, you the capacity to work with both energies, striking a balance between the Saturn's limits and Neptune's absolute lack of them. At its best, you two will find creative ways to use Saturn's sturdiness to anchor Neptune's visionary quality into practical forms. This placement can also indicate a relationship that has reached a level of spiritual attainment where you share a deep, subtle acceptance of whatever is happening. This state of acceptance is no small thing, and in fact, it lies at the very heart of the esoteric teachings within most of the great religions.

Composite Saturn in weak opposition (fading, 4.7 degrees) with Pluto

The planetary energies are polarized; outer events stimulate their interaction; integration is the challenge.

This aspect between composite Saturn and Pluto brings forcefulness to your partnership as formidable as a tidal wave and as transformational as a bonfire is to a pile of wood. With this placement, you find yourself part of relationship that comes with a focus on issues of authority, power and control, with also the benefit of radical transformation. Saturn represents the controlling powers-that-be, while Pluto represents the urge to transform or destroy this status quo, and in your relationship these energies are in conflict. In personal relationships, you may have to beware of turning this immense force onto each other. You benefit when you work through any compulsion that arises within the relationship regarding personal power or attitudes toward established authority. You have the opportunity here to help each other reevaluate and transform your urge for power and control based on a deeper understanding of the very nature of power itself. It may be difficult to achieve, but if you can work through these issues, you are likely to develop a more conscious and socially responsible use of personal power that could assist in your own evolution and that of the world around you.

Composite Uranus in weak trine (fading, 7.8 degrees) with Chiron

The planetary energies flow smoothly; the connection is easy and beneficial.

With this aspect in your composite chart your relationship has a strong spiritual connection with it's own unique brand of philosophical outlook. As a partnership, you are likely to be prone to sudden insights and departures from consensus thinking. One or both of you probably has an unusual combination of personality traits in which you are very unconventional yet also somewhat unsure of yourself in your very departure from the rest of society, so that you may surprisingly show flashes of a conservative side. You are likely to have brilliant and refreshingly unconventional minds, and this combination of personality traits may have drawn you to each other in the first place. Now you can form a conspiracy of two that defeats the pressure to conform that constantly comes at you from the surrounding social setting. In this way, and with this very important support for each other, your relationship can be extraordinarily healing for you both, especially in the area of your own uncertainties regarding your resistance to the straight and narrow. This aspect is the signature of an approach to life that includes shamanism and new age healing techniques as an innovative form. You have a creative perspective that allows you to go far in pursuing your own unique brand of spirituality.

Composite Pluto in weak trine (fading, 8.1 degrees) with Midheaven

The planetary energies flow smoothly; the connection is easy and beneficial.

This aspect between composite Pluto and the Midheaven brings to your relationship a passionate intensity and also a great potential for personal evolution. There is a depth to your connection with each other that may not seem obvious on the surface, but which over time you find is there. In a romantic connection, the possibility is there for adherence to and departure from issues of who has the authority at any given moment. The sexual arena is one place that these control issues may manifest. As a partnership you make a dedicated and charismatic pairing, and can accomplish great things together once you figure out where and how far you want to go in order to make your strongest contribution to the society that surrounds you.

Glossary

- Ascendant: The point in the sky of the Eastern horizon. In the chart, the Ascendant is represented by the horizontal line at the left hand side of the chart which crosses between the Twelfth and First Houses. The sign on the Ascendant is also referred to as the Rising Sign.
- Aspects: When the relative positions of two planets in the horoscope form a significant angle with each other, they are said to be in aspect with one another. The type and quality of the aspect is determined by the number of degrees between the two planets and is only considered significant if it is within a narrow range of degrees, or orb. A list of the aspects used in this report is given below.

Conjunction $-0^{\circ} \pm 8$ degrees Square $-90^{\circ} \pm 8$ degrees

Opposition — $180^{\circ} \pm 8$ degrees Trine — $120^{\circ} \pm 8$ degrees Sextile $-60^{\circ} \pm 6$ degrees Inconjunct $-150^{\circ} \pm 4$ degrees

- *Chart Comparison*: An astrological technique in which the planets of two individuals are shown in a bi-wheel chart, one within the other. This allows the interaspects between the two charts to be examined.
- *Composite Chart*: An astrological technique in which the midpoints of two individuals' planetary positions are used to create a third chart, the composite chart, which is then interpreted as the chart of the relationship itself as an independent entity.
- *Horoscope*: Originally horoscope referred to the astrological chart itself, but is now popularly used to refer to the description of how current planetary positions are affecting you personally, as in "your monthly horoscope."
- *Midheaven*: The point in the sky directly overhead relative to the position on Earth. In the chart, the Midheaven is represented by the vertical line at the top of the chart between the Ninth and Tenth Houses.
- *Natal*: From Latin, meaning of or pertaining to birth; therefore your birth chart, or planetary positions at birth.
- *Nodes*: The Lunar Nodes are the two points where the Moon's orbital path crosses the plane of the ecliptic (the plane of the Earth's orbit around the Sun). Symbolically they represent talents and life path, or destiny.
- *Planets*: In astrology, the word planets is used to describe astrologically significant points in the sky which includes the Sun and Moon, as well as many objects that are not currently astronomically defined as planets such as Chiron and Pluto.
- *Transits*: Aspects formed between the current positions of the planets and the positions of your natal planets at the time and place you were born.
